


## TEAHAUS - TREEHAUS

High into the corona of one of the trees of Reford Gardens, a small traditional teahouse built citing the "CHASHITU" style with the typical shoji windows of translucent japanese paper and sliding doors, is constructed. This simple wooden building can be reached by climbing a long wooden ladder.

To approach this fragile ladder, the visitor passes through a replique of a typical traditional japanese stone "ZEN" garden, which is temporarily created in the surroundings oft the house - carrying tree.

During the whole festival period, following a regular scedule, a japanese tea master mounts the ladder to perform the traditional tea ceremony for those who are interested in expierencing it. Up to three visiting people can take part in each session.

Teahouse - Treehouse thus offers a very direct approach to an intensiv contemplative interactiv natur experience and simultaniously enables city dwellers and other contemporarians to expierence a meditative break from the overwhelming outside world.
