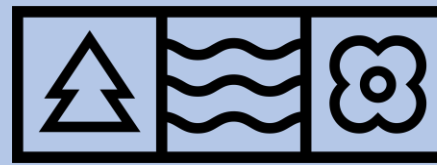

National historic site of Canada and heritage site of Quebec, the Reford Gardens are a must-see. Cultural space, tourist destination for more than 50 years, emblematic landscapes, the Reford Gardens offer visitors experiences of connection to nature that are both soothing and innovative. Located at the confluence of the St. Lawrence River and the Mitis River, they were designed by adventurous horticulturalist Elsie Reford from 1926 to 1958, in addition to being one of the North American gardens and the 150 best gardens in the world.
